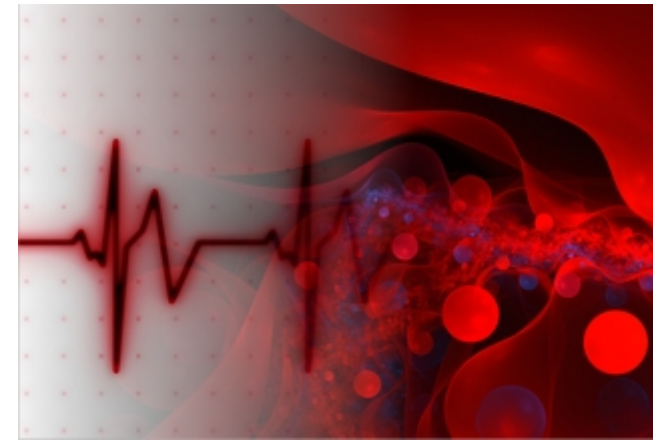
Contact Hours: Continuing nursing education contact hours will be awarded by the Massachusetts Nurses Association.
