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Safe Patient Limits in the ICU - IT'S THE LAW!

- · A new law setting safe patient limits for ALL ICU nurses is now in effect and all hospitals must comply with the law.
- The new law requires that a nurse be assigned one patient at a time or a second patient only if the staff nurses on the unit have assessed that it is safe for both patients.

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- Manager and supervisors have a say in your assignment ONLY in those instances where you and your colleagues disagree on the assessment of patients.
- In no instance can you be assigned a third patient, and in no instance can your patient assignment be increased due to a nurse going on break or a nurse leaving the unit with another patient.
- If a manager or supervisor attempts to overrule your patient assessment and forces you to accept a second patient, inform them that they are violating state law and you intend to report the violation to the State's Health Policy Commission and the DPH.
- If management persists in violating the law, fill out the Violation of the ICU If management persists in violating the law, in out the Violation Law form, and the MNA will file this complaint with the HPC and DPH.
